section 2.- The members of the Board of Directors shall hold office until their death or resignation, or until they are removed with or without cause by the affirmative vote of no fewer than two-thirds of the members of the Board of Directors and with the concarrence of the Chief Priest.

Section 5.— Each member of the Board of Directors shall have one vote. No director shall cumulate his votes. A majority of the Board shall constitute a quorum.
