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How's Your Connection?

When you pick up your telephone receiver you are assured in mind even before you attempt to make a contact that you will speak to the person you are calling. From the moment you lift the receiver this assurance extends and continues for as long as you wish to converse. That the instrument might fail seldom enters your mind.

The progressive action in the course of talking by telephone is most interesting. Your articulate speech into a microphone cause vibrations which are directly transmitted along a wire connecting your instrument to a distant receiver. The sound of your voice is converted into electrical impulses or varying currents which are clearly distinguished by your recipient, as his voice is to you.

Only a live wire can function properly in service. A dead wire has no value. Electricity enlivens the connecting wire and conversation between distant points is possible.

Telephoning is such common practice that our imagination remains somewhat static. As we press our idea, we go to wireless telephony. In this, sound waves are launched into space which, in turn, are picked up by the essential

apparatus. We can converse freely with friends at sea or on land. No connecting wire is provided, yet the same force possessing potential energy serves to carry the sound of our voice.

Often, while speaking to another, not only is our voice clear, but the silent thoughts accompanying our words register with clarity. The substance or essence of what we believe and feel, though not expressly stated, is received by fair inference.

Since ordinary speech can flow freely between given points by means of electrical energy, whether conducted by wire or launched into space, we should familiarize ourselves with a more transcendent energy called Spirit. By it our prayers and God's inspirations interchange in direct communion. No instrument is required.

Many people launch their prayers into space hoping their God will have time to tune in, hear, and answer. They are greatly concerned with their message to Him and usually too impatient to wait for an answer. So, their negative demands become their answers, for their incessant requests are all they can hear.

We have discovered a private system of communication with the Father over a direct line always alive, never out of order, and freed from traffic night or day. This line is not material nor is it mental. It is the path of silent vision toward God and is revealed when the rules of contact are obeyed. "Look unto me." Look up; make straight the path of the Lord; watch; wait. Keep the attention trained toward the mystical uplands above thinking and above being, whence cometh all help and wait patiently for the Lord.

Your looking-apparatus is within you, always in perfect repair, ready for instant use. Since God is the Dispenser of Good Gifts, it is wise to look toward Him even before voicing your plea. The good receiver hears His Word clearly and always gets good results.

If you must speak, report to God according to His Word, not your own, and you will be delighted to find yourself receiving everything you want. His word was in the beginning, and still is, GOOD.
